Special Patients In Need was established in 1999 to help patients receive their medications at a *fraction* of the cost. Our company works directly with the pharmaceutical companies, American Red Cross, United Way and Division of Family and Children Services (DFCS) to help people who cannot afford to pay for their medications. Our company is able to provide patients with their medications at a fraction of the cost provided that their income is within the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Special Patients In Need is one of the first companies to educate people about pharmaceutical companies and the existence of Patient Assistance Programs. Our company qualifies patients for their medications through the pharmaceutical companies' Patient Assistance Programs. Our company completes the necessary documents and applications that are required by the pharmaceutical companies. Next, we deliver the documents and applications to both the patient and their physician in order to obtain their signatures. After the documents and applications are properly executed we deliver them to the appropriate pharmaceutical company. Our company keeps track of the status of the patient's medications. In approximately four to six weeks, the pharmaceutical company will deliver the medications to the patient's doctor. After approximately three months, our company will then re-orders the patient's medications. We ensure that our patients *never* go without their medications. *This is always our mission! Special Patients In Need charges a nominal application for completing all the required documents and applications so that our patient can receive a three-months supply of their medications. Fees may vary if the pharmaceutical company provides an entire years supply of the patient's medications. Let us tell you with a quick phone call if you qualify.*
